



Your Personal Course Planning Guide

Vergil is a web application to assist students with the course planning process prior to registration. This service consolidates and integrates information currently available to students across several different platforms.

Through new protocols, Vergil enables a more informed and efficient course planning process for students.

Vergil Provides:

- **Consolidated course-related information** across various platforms, such as the Directory of Classes (DOC), CourseWorks, and school bulletins;
- **Ability for students to intuitively browse courses offered each semester**, while also accessing course information for multiple terms;
- **Integrated course features**, including accessing syllabi, textbook information, and course evaluations, when available.

Features Include:

- **Smart search** is enabled on keywords, instructor name, semester, year, department, subject area, course level, date and time, and their combinations;
- Enables students to **save courses of interest in a course planner** and move these courses to a **graphical calendar interface that is exportable** to other calendar applications;
- Permits students to **export courses from their calendars to SSOL Wish Lists, which can then be used directly for registration.**
